The Show House will be open to the public

May 7 - May 22, 2016

Monday - Friday: 10 am - 3 pm
Tues, Wed & Thurs: 6:30 pm - 8:30 pm
Saturday: 10 am - 5 pm
Sunday: Noon - 5 pm

Guided tours will be available for groups of 10 or more at the rate of \$20 per person.

Tours will be scheduled during all regular public hours and before opening, but no earlier than 9 am, Monday through Saturday and 11:00 am Sunday. Evening tours on Tuesdays, Wednesdays or Thursdays will be scheduled no earlier than 6:00 pm.

Reserved times are essential, as all tours must begin promptly.

IMPORTANT

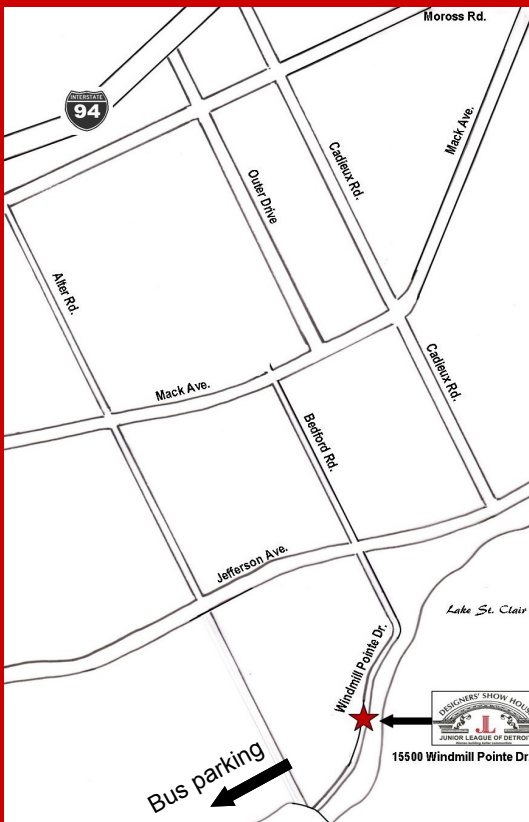
There are many narrow stairways, please wear comfortable walking shoes.

The house is NOT handicap accessible. There is no available seating inside the decorated home.

Babies and children under the age of 8 are not permitted to tour the Show House, including babes in arms, carriers or strollers.

Pets or other animals are not allowed into the home, carried pets included.

Photos of the finished rooms or interior areas are not allowed.



- ◆ Convenient parking is available on both sides of Windmill Pointe Drive and on the side streets.
- ◆ Charter buses may drop off and pick up in front of the home; bus parking will be available at Windmill Pointe Park.
- ◆ For planning purposes, allow up to 2 hours to tour the home and grounds.
- ◆ The Café will be open during tours, with seating in the Tavern or in the tent on the grounds. Other dining options are available upon request.
- ◆ The MarketPlace will be open for shopping after your tour.

ABOUT THE HOUSE



The historically significant home on the shores of Lake St. Clair was built in 1927 for Colonel Jesse G. Vincent, inventor and VP Engineering of the Packard Motor Car Company and his wife. The 5,300 s/f Tudor-styled home retains many of its original features, including a canal that bisects the yard from the lake to the dry dock built below the living room.

The interior rooms have been reimagined and brought to life by many of Metro Detroit's most talented Interior Designers, and the expansive property has been totally renovated by area landscapers. There are a number of surprise features in the gardens of this waterfront home, and they are show-stoppers!

Our *Café* in the original Tavern in the lower level will be open for lunch or a snack, and outdoor (tent) seating is available to enjoy the lake views.

Our *MarketPlace* in the attached garage and tents will feature local artisans and shops selling their wares.

We hope you will make plans to tour the 2016 Show House, and we look forward to your visit!
